LENGTH: 500–750 words. Pages should be typed and double-spaced or neatly handwritten in ink and stapled. **Note:** Spelling and grammar count.

DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, **Dec. 1, 2010**. All entries become the property of Maryknoll and cannot be returned. Winning entries will be published in the May/June 2011 MARYKNOLL magazine and online at www.maryknollsociety.org/winners.
