Payroll Presentation

We have added a short PowerPoint presentation titled "Payroll for Archdiocese" to the Payroll section of the Administrators benefits web site. The presentation is not intended to teach how to process payroll (contact ADP directly for that), but rather to describe the fields that are unique to Archdiocesan payrolls for parishes, schools and agencies. This is particularly designed for new Payroll Administrators, but all may find it helpful. It's only 12 slides in length so it shouldn't take too long to view it. By filling out the "POLICY ACKNOWL-EDGED" field in the database, it will make it easier for you to track your employees and volunteers who have/have not met the Safe Environment Requirements. Please fill out this important section of your employees/volunteers profiles.
