- SMU's School Administration Certification program provides future educational leaders with a flexible route to becoming a school principal or program administrator.
- The program is designed for individuals who have earned an undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university and typically have three years of professionally oriented work experience in an educational setting. Options are available for candidates to enroll in the certification program only (if they have a Master's degree) or the Master's in Education and certification program together.
- The program includes accredited professional standards coursework that is offered evenings, weekends and summers and a supervised internship. After an intensive summer academy of core administrative courses (June 27-August 5, 2011), candidates are typically ready for their year-long administrative internship.
- The information sessions will address entry requirements, program details, required classes and the internship, financial information and administrator certification.
- Applications for the program are being accepted now and will be considered in the order received. Most participants may begin classes during the summer 2011.
