What is the Theology of the Body?

The Theology of the Body is a study of life, love, and the human person in the context of God's eternal plan for salvation. Between the years of 1979 and 1984, Pope John Paul II dedicated his first 129 Wednesday audiences to the teachings of Christ and the Catholic Church in regards to the real meaning of love and God's plan for human relationships.

As he explains, the physical human body has a specific meaning and is capable of revealing answers regarding fundamental questions about us and our lives:

- Is there a real purpose to life and if so, what is it?
- Why were we created male and female? Does it really matter?
- Why did God give us desires for love?
- What is the purpose of the married and celibate vocations?
- What exactly is "Love"?
- What does chastity really mean and is it truly possible to be pure of heart?
- What is God's plan for my life?
- Plus much, much more...

The Theology of the Body has the capability to transform lives and relationships in a way that can ultimately transform this world. As George Weigel, author of Pope John Paul II's biography Witness to Hope, says, "John Paul's theology of the body not only paves the way for lasting renewal of marriage and the family; it enables everyone to rediscover 'the meaning of the whole of existence, the meaning of life."

This program will connect the Church's teachings on Social Justice with those on Sexual Morality. Course reading will include *Morality: The Catholic View* by Servais Pinckaers, OP, and how his theology helped underpin catechesis, especially the third pillar of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. Central to all presentations will be Pope John Paul II's *Theology of the Body* and the way it animates social and sexual morality. This program is designed for the leadership in secondary schools and for those involved in Senior High and Junior High Youth Ministries and religious leaders charged with moral formation.
