What We Are Looking For

Contest entries will be judged on the below criteria. Contestants are encouraged to read the questions below and focus on a few to answer. We also encourage young people to PLAN ways to address this theme throughout the school year and to document them for their entries.

- How do we act as Jesus did?
- How do we share our faith in words?
- How do we learn from other religions and traditions?
- How do we protect God's creation and the rights of others?
- How do we learn from and respect the cultures of people with whom we serve?
- How does liturgy and prayer strengthen and guide us in Christ's mission?
- How do we learn from our mistakes and ask forgiveness?

<i>Contest Theme</i>	Student participants give little explanation of they act as Christ's body now on Earth.	Student participants address how they act as Christ's body now on Earth., but examples are unclear to audience or participants. <i>Categories of Mission</i>	Entry provides few examples of how participants live out mission, or examples do not clearly correlate with questions above.	Entry provides examples of how participants live out mission, but most are either not clear or not strongly tied to the questions above.	Entry provides clear examples of how participants live mission, but some examples could relate more strongly to the questions above.	Entry provides clear, strong examples of participants live out mission according to the questions above.
<i>Creativity</i>	Students show little creativity in both how they live out mission and in the contest entry.	Students show slight creativity in how they live out mission and in the contest entry, or show creativity in one area but not in the other.	Students show creativity in how they live out mission or in the contest entry, but one of these areas could be stronger.	Students show creativity in how they live out mission, and show creativity in the contest entry.
<i>Effort</i>	Contest entry demonstrates little student effort.	Contest entry demonstrates an adequate level of student effort.	Contest entry demonstrates a high level of student effort.
