

## Mission Education Training Program for Teachers *Continuing Pentecost Today*

## Goals

- Train and empower teachers to:
  - Appreciate the significance of mission to their own personal and ministerial identity
  - Understand the scriptural, historical and theological foundations of mission and evangelization and the current models and methods of mission
  - o Grow in a spirituality grounded in global solidarity
  - Develop skills and resources to incorporate mission education into their own educational ministry

**PROGRAM NOTE**: The programs listed below vary in length and depth of coverage. Although some areas of focus are the same between programs, the detail with which these areas are engaged will vary significantly.

## Programs:

- Two-Day Session
  - o Logistics
    - Module consists of sessions that are 2 1/2 hours in length, using adult learning methods and include integration of prayer and spirituality
    - Sessions are typically held over 2 days (i.e. a weekend), or over 4 evenings.
    - Overnight accommodations are available at the Regional Center for small groups.
    - Groups to be kept small (no more than 6) to ensure individual attention.
  - Areas of Focus
    - Scriptural foundations of mission
    - Historical understandings of mission
    - Models and methods of mission today
    - Mission and the school curriculum
    - The mission educator
    - Developing mission education opportunities
- Day Session
  - o Logistics
    - Module consists of sessions held at school using adult learning methods and include integration of prayer and spirituality
    - Sessions held over one full work day, typically as faculty inservice
    - Can accommodate faculty groups of 30 or less
  - Areas of Focus
    - Scriptural foundations of mission
    - Historical understandings of mission

- Mission and the school curriculum

## Half-Day Session

- o Logistics
  - Module consists of sessions held at school using adult learning methods and include integration of prayer and spirituality
  - Sessions held over a three to four hour period, typically as faculty in-service
  - Can accommodate faculty groups of 30 or less
- Areas of Focus
  - Scriptural foundations of mission
  - Models and methods of mission today
  - Opportunities for integration into school curriculum
- Hour-Long Session
  - o Logistics
    - Module consists of a brief overview of mission as it relates to educational ministry
    - Session held at school over an hour period, typically as part of a staff meeting
    - Can accommodate faculty groups of 30 or less
  - o Areas of Focus
    - Scriptural foundations of mission
    - Models and methods of mission today
