Project

- Have students dictate an explanation of their pictures (or write an explanation/title, if appropriate for grade level).

Grades K - 2

Our relationships with friends and family are precious gifts from God. Taking care of our relationships means to be respectful to each other and to care for one another.

Project

- Title the bulletin board; We Love Our Neighbors As Ourselves (or base title on another appropriate scripture or quote, such as below.)
- Draw and cut out heart shapes, or direct students to do this.
- Have each student bring a picture from home and post onto white construction paper. (Alternative; Have each student draw a picture of their face on white construction paper.)
- Create name labels for each student.
 (Alternative; have each student draw their names under their self-portraits.)
- Place each student's picture on the board to symbolize good relationships and God's love for each other in the classroom. Have students color or decorate hearts.
