Qualifications

Dr. Leo Gómez and Dr. Richard Gómez Jr., Bilingual/ESL professors, developed the Gómez & Gómez Dual Language Enrichment (DLE) Model in 1995. They have worked in the field of Bilingual/ESL Education and are offering a three-day training workshop entitled *Dual Language Training Institute*. It is especially applicable to schools currently implementing a dual language program or *considering implementing in the near future*. This 3-day workshop provides the tools to establish and sustain a Two-way DL Program for all students (both groups) or a One-way DL Program for Bilingual Learners (BLs) only (also referred to as ELLs or LEP).

Over the last 18 years, they have focused their research on linguistic and academic issues that effect language minority populations, particularly Spanish dominant bilingual learners. They have published several articles on dual language education, describing the need for schools to implement enrichment models of bilingual education that not only more effectively educate bilingual learners, but all children. To this end, they have been extensively involved in the development, implementation and assessment of One-Way & Two-Way Dual Language programs implementing a **Dual Language** Enrichment (DLE) Model they originally developed in 1995. The consistent implementation of this model has proven effective in improving the long-term academic and linguistic achievement (based on standardized test results in reading & mathematics) of Spanish and English dominant students. Today, the Gómez & Gómez DLE Model is successfully being implemented in over 550 elementary schools across six states: Texas, Washington, Nevada, Kansas, California, and Alaska. In Texas alone, this model is successfully being implemented in 532 elementary schools across 62 school districts.

Dr. Leo Gómez and Dr. Richard Gómez Jr. have conducted countless professional development workshops on dual language program development and classroom implementation, as well as other areas in the field of bilingual/ESL education. They also have secured, administered and evaluated Title VII and Title III Bilingual/ESL grant programs.
