Step 1: Announcements

- ☐ Put in Bulletin / on Website
- ☐ Give Flier to all Parish Commission / Committee Chairs to share
- ☐ Mention in Pastor's letter
- ☐ Post in Church
- ☐ Announce at Mass



Step 2: Gather the Community for the Common Good

- ☐ Designate a person & committee to coordinate Advocacy Day participation
- ☐ Set a quota (minimum 5) to participate: _____
- ☐ Make a list of parishioners to personally invite—call them
- ☐ Invite parish committees to have a representative participate in Catholic Advocacy Day
- ☐ Ask parish staff to identify 1-5 people to go to Olympia
- ☐ Life, Justice & Peace / JustFaith / Social Justice / Outreach make this a priority project

Step 4: Transportation

- ☐ Organize carpooling to Olympia—St. Michael's & Capitol Building—on February 15th (minimum 1 car of 5)
- ☐ Call the Intercommunity Peace & Justice Center (IPJC) for space availability on the buses leaving Seattle & Tacoma
- ☐ Consider a deanery or parish bus or van
