

Guatemala: Immersion for Teachers

Better connect your parish and school community with God's mission of global solidarity, peace, and justice by participating in the Maryknoll Teacher Immersion Program. Join us this June for an unique immersion experience led by the Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers.



June 19th-27th, 2012
8 day trip, limited to 8-10 teachers

Immersion Trip Includes:

- Pre-trip orientation
- Professional development
- Accommodations and in-country travel
- Encounter with school and youth life
- On-site presentations by local school faculty
- Visits to tourist and cultural sites including the famous Basilica del Cristo Negro
- Immersion into the cultures and peoples of Guatemala
- Post-trip debriefing and reflection

Trip Funding

We encourage parish and school communities to **Send a Teacher on Mission** by helping to fund the cost of the program. Ideally, the school raises half of the costs, and the participating teacher pays for the other half.

- Fundraising Goal: \$700
- Additional Cost to Teacher: \$700

(Projections include cost of airfare, as well as in-country meal, lodging, and transportation costs.)

- Formation and development of the teacher to better integrate Catholic identity
- Engage the parish & school community in global solidarity, justice, and the challenge of spreading the love of God
- Maryknoll will work with the teacher to bring the immersion experience back to the local community
