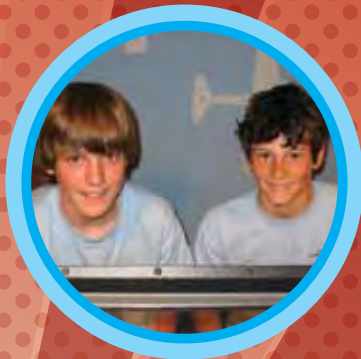
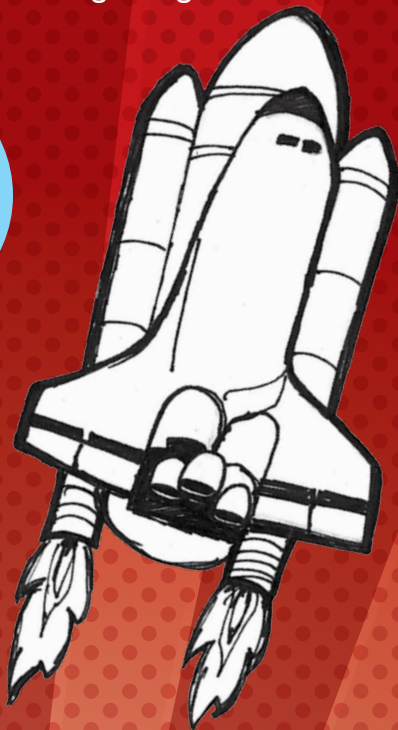

Blast Off!

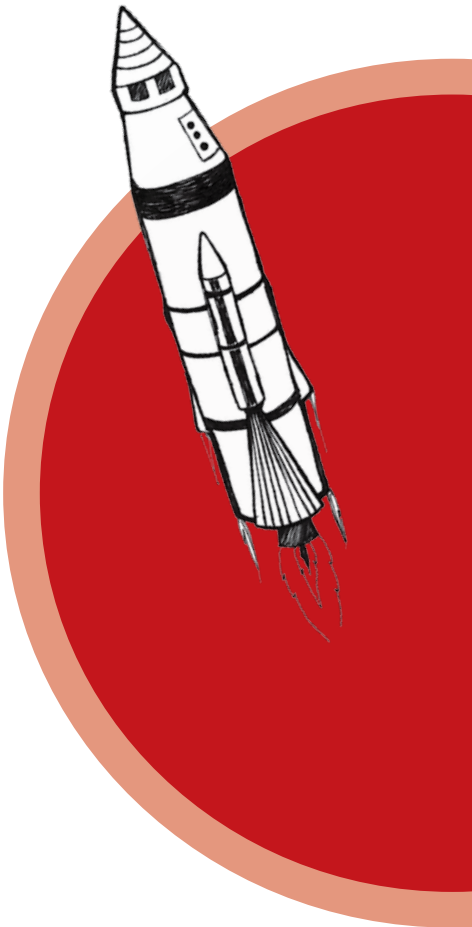

ACE Apprentices is a pathway of the Museum Apprentice Program (MAP) where participating students will learn about all aspects of a summer camp. Each apprentice will spend time interacting with campers, developing programs, and assisting with other camp-related duties. Apprentices will also have the opportunity to participate in trips during the summer.

ACE Apprentices must complete one week of training. Training is offered June 25 – June 29 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. After completing training, Apprentices must volunteer a minimum of 35 hours during the summer but will be able to create their own volunteer schedule.

Extended Care

Extended Care is available from 7 to 9 a.m. Monday – Friday and 4 to 6 p.m. Monday – Thursday. There is no afternoon Extended Care on Fridays. Campers in extended care are supervised by our Extended Care staff and will play games, read books, draw, color, and participate in other activities.

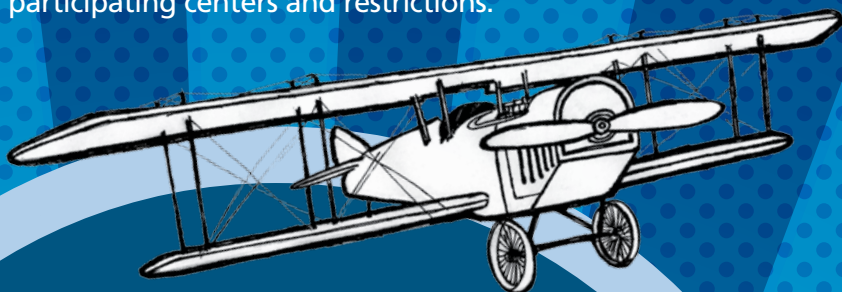

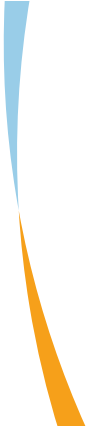
