Greetings!

October is an exciting month for mission! Not only do we celebrate [World Mission Sunday](#) on the 21st, but October 11th marks the 50th anniversary of the Second Vatican Council. The Council reclaimed and articulated the notion that, as Christians, we "cherish a feeling of deep solidarity" with people all over the world, "especially those who are poor or afflicted in any way." 50 years later, so many of us are still discovering Christ through our relationship with the poor and disadvantaged.

This month, I travel to Haiti with a group from St. Anthony's Parish in Renton, WA. They are embarking on a sister parish relationship and we are making our first visit. Right now, two local Affiliates are [preparing to serve](#) as Maryknoll Lay Missioners, one in Tanzania and one in Cambodia. Two other Affiliates are making their annual return to Tanzania, this time bringing along a newcomer. As you read this, teachers are discerning whether to embark on a [Maryknoll Immersion](#) this summer, while other teachers are excited to integrate their recent immersion experience into the classroom.


