Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) continues to offer pre-AP and AP teachers

professional development to improve the quality of teaching and learning. This year, trainings began in August with 3 days of STEM focused AP and SpringBoard (ELA and Math). The 20 AP Boost high schools held trainings were in partnership with the California Science Center. LAUSD continued offering trainings on October 6th, (CA Science Center) on October 13th and December 1, 2012 at UCLA. This year, our region has supported LAUSD with 30 full-day content specific trainings ranging from SpringBoard (ELA and math), PreAP, counselor AP Exam Administration, and NOSCA support, as well as, in the following specific AP content areas: AP English Language and Composition, AP
