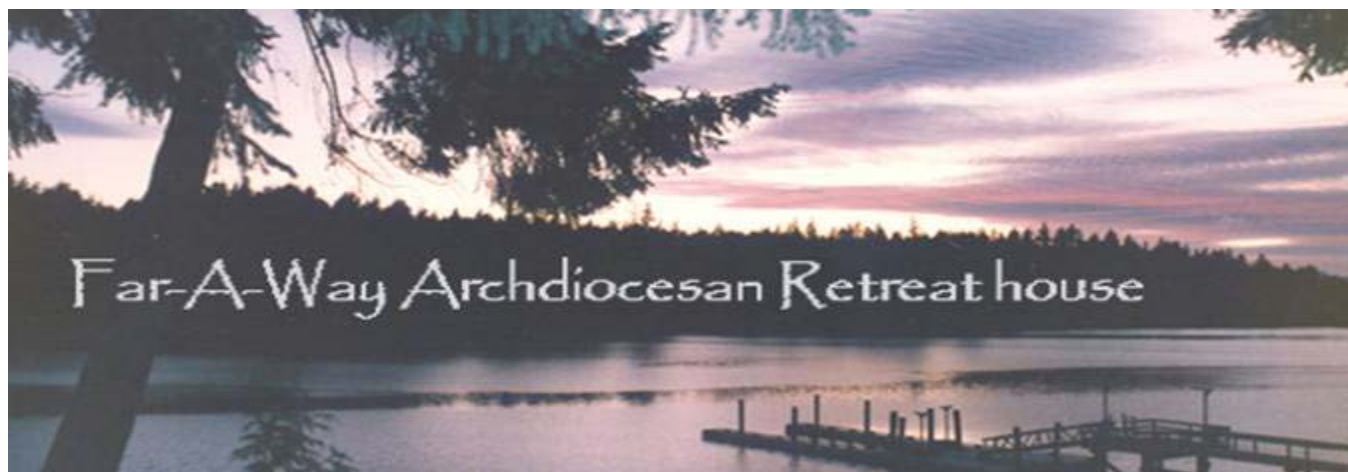

Note that the facility "One Day Use" price is for day only gatherings including partial days. This price does not apply to those using the Cottage for overnight stays. If you are staying overnight, the per night prices applies.

For those using the cottage for 7 days or longer, a Damage Deposit of \$200 may also be requested at the time of your reservation. This Damage Deposit will be applied if a group requires more than basic clean up for their stay. Additional Labor Charges may be added if costs exceed the Damage Deposit.

Base prices for the Cottage at Far-A-Way are:

Price may vary based on time of year and overall use of Far-A-Way

One Day Rental (Day only) of the Cottage - \$150 per day

One Night Rental of Cottage - \$210 per night

One Week Rental of Cottage - \$1225 (\$175 per night)

One Month Rental of Cottage - \$4500 (\$150 per night)
