## **Notes from PFS**

#### **Parish Ordinary Income Survey:**

As you recall, we requested a report of Parish Ordinary Income for the first six months of 12/13 vs. 11/12. We got a good response with 121 communities responding; these communities accounted for 75% of the 11/12 Ordinary Income so the sample should be meaningful. Ordinary Income for the reporting entities increased 3.36% for the first six months of 12/13. 89 or 73% of the reporting communities had an increase. 31 of these had a decrease in 11/12. It doesn't seem that we are out of the economic woods yet but we do seem to be recovering a little bit.



#### **Charitable Withholding:**

Over the past few years several companies have set up a service to withhold charitable contributions from their employees pay checks. In the past we have always advised parishes that the withholding entity will provide a tax receipt. We recently found out that Microsoft tells employees that the recipient organization will provide the tax receipt.

This isn't a problem but it does point out very clearly that each of these organizations has their own rules and we need to try to keep current on what the requirements are. It's really similar to the matching gift programs that are all slightly different but provide basically the same service. Try to make sure you know the rules before you get involved.

# **Application for Special Events Coverage**

Catholic Mutual has once again updated the **Application For Special Events Coverage** with a couple of new features, including the option to purchase Liquor Liability coverage for events where alcohol is being sold, such as fundraisers. Events lasting longer than three days will now also be allowed with an additional charge depending on the duration. Inflatable amusement devices (bouncy houses) will be charged a flat rate of \$100 per device but must be pre-approved and a picture provided. Otherwise, the cost for the coverage remains the same. We encourage everyone to read over the new application and call Catholic Mutual if you have any questions.

Please remember that archdiocesan parish/school events are not permitted at private residences due to liability concerns and Safe Environment policies. #### **BACKGROUND CHECK CHECK-IN**

- Please remember that background checks will only be processed if they are submitted with a valid Social Security Number. If a background check is submitted without a valid SSN, the background check results will be sent back to say that we were unable to verify the SSN and they are not eligible to work or volunteer until the SSN issue is cleared up.
  - ♦ This includes an incomplete SSN, a SSN submitted with only zero's, a SSN that has not been typed correctly or a SSN that cannot be verified through the Social Security Administration.
- Please remember to include the SETA Net ID number when you submit a background check. This is the only way to connect background check results with a participant's SETA Net profile or your monthly compliance reports.
- If you ever receive results that say that a valid driver's license must be verified before someone is allowed to drive, did you know that you can check that online? 


