Recognizing instructional and assessment implications of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) is
essential for all educators. The CCSS describe what students should know in order to succeed beyond
high school, but they do not specify how students should learn the subject matter. The CCSS do not
address individual variations in learning. Ensuring that students with language-based learning disabilities
are able to achieve mastery of the CCSS requires an understanding of the challenges posed by their
implementation.
