The second annual *Living for Others* workshop/retreat will focus on the BIG questions, such as:

- What is Happiness?
- Is God really Unconditionally Loving and Forgiving?
- Why does God allow Suffering?

In keeping with the Year of Faith, this year's *Living for Others* will offer an opportunity to more deeply understand the documents of Vatican II and the Catechism and why the life and dignity of the human person is the foundation of Catholic social and moral teaching, including the Theology of the Body.

In addition to thought-provoking presentations, participants will take part in small group discussions, interesting activities, and several meditations derived from the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius. There will be one session devoted to learning about the *new high school curriculum*, *Principles and Choices*, which can also be used in Confirmation classes, youth groups, junior high classrooms, and for adult faith formation.

This program is designed for the Teachers and Principals in secondary schools and will be useful to Youth Ministers, Junior High, and adult religious leaders charged with moral formation. Others interested in Catholic moral and social teaching are also encouraged to participate.
