CONTEST RULES

The contest is open to students enrolled in Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Seattle.

Essays should answer the following question:

"How are faith, knowledge and service related to each other in your Catholic school education, and in the rest of your life?"

Word limits for the essays are as follows:

- Grades K-5: 250 words
- Grades 6-8: 350 words
- Grades 9-12: 500 words

All essays must be received by NORTHWEST CATHOLIC **no later than October 1, 2013**. Winners will be notified no later than October 15.

Entries should include the student's name, address, email address, contact phone number, school name (and city), and grade level.
