Steps for launching, revising, or celebrating the planning process will be outlined, including examples from parish, school, and diocesan settings across the country. This is the first webinar in a series of three focused on catechetical planning for clergy, catechetical leaders, and advisory groups responsible for religious education and faith formation.

- Describe the importance and benefits of catechetical planning in Catholic parish, school, and diocesan settings.
- Define the role of advisory groups in effective catechetical planning.
- Outline steps in effective catechetical planning, including developing a "rolling plan."
