What is 'The Church Engaged'?

- Concept created and driven by Gallup to give parishes a tool to recognize 'talents' and to measure and increase parishioner engagement
- Demonstrated, measurable effectiveness in increasing parishioner participation and treasure
- Backed by the science of Gallup
- Creates new paradigm: "Belonging Leads to Believing"
- Empirical model that measures CAUSES of spiritual commitment and engagement, not just OUTCOMES
- Powerful tool for Evangelization
- Provides specific strategies to help parishes lead their faith communities, applying a twofold program:
 - Identify Talents with the use of the Clifton 'Strengths Finder' tool. Gallup has customized this
 affirming self-discovery tool for specific relevance to the Church. It enables parishioners to
 identify their unique, God-given talent themes.
 - Engage Parishioners Assess the engagement of parishioners and provide 'small group'
 workshops and leadership training for the purpose of increasing engagement. Tactical steps are
 identified for parish leaders to help parishioners use their natural talents for personal growth and
 service to others, especially within the context of parish ministries and outreach.
