

1.2 Introduction to the Bible and Tradition

Begin with an overview of the Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, and understand its various literary forms, genres, and key themes. Explore Divine Revelation as it relates to the Catholic understanding of Scripture and Tradition. Discuss the process of arriving at the Canon of Scripture and learn about the methods of Biblical interpretation. Become familiar with the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, its significance, and uses.

1.7 The Founding of the Church

Focus on the significance of Apostolic Succession and the roles of the hierarchy as the Church moved through the centuries, formulating a Creed, defining the Canon of Scripture, and developing the Sacraments. Examine how the Sacraments foster holiness, community, and continuity with the Apostolic Church.

3.4 The Letters of Paul

Look at Paul's cultural, religious, and social background and the story of his conversion. Review his missionary journeys and the importance of his letters to the First Century Christian communities. Explore the three major theological tensions in Paul's ministry and the four theological convictions held by him.
