Dear Principal,

Greetings in the Risen Lord!

As you know, each year we are audited by the Office of Child & Youth Protection of the USCCB. In order for the Archdiocese of Seattle to fulfill our audit obligations, all schools must submit a written verification form to confirm that all Safe Environment requirements have been met. In normal circumstances, this form is due into the Safe Environment Program by the end of May.

However, with the tax fraud investigation, this has been anything but a normal year! In light of the implementation of the new background check system, and the challenges that it has created in the schools, we are extending the deadline as late as we can this year.

All requirements must be met and both forms of verification completed by June 15, 2014.

Compliance of all Safe Environment requirements must be verified in two ways:

- 1) A written verification form to confirm that all Safe Environment requirements have been met must be signed by the principal and returned to by June 15, 2014.
- 2) Student attendance numbers must be reported in the SETA Net Database for all student classes. Each student must be accounted for to the USCCB. Therefore, please report the total number of students in the class, the number that participated and the number (if any) that opted-out. Attendance must be submitted by June 15, 2014.

The annual verification process is necessary in order to accurately report our Safe Environment information and complete the USCCB audit. We must have all the forms and data in by this date to ensure that we can meet the USCCB deadlines for the Archdiocese as a whole.

All required training, student attendance numbers and the signed verification form are due by June 15, 2014. Please call the Safe Environment office with any questions, (206) 274-3188 or email us at <a href="mailto:sep@seattlearch.org">sep@seattlearch.org</a>.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR REPORTING STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAININGS

Attendance for children and youth must be recorded in SETA Net Database by June 15, 2014.

Please make sure you are <u>NOT</u> logged in as an administrator.

#### Go to SETA Net Home Page:

- www.seattle.setanet.org
- Click on the link that is titled, "Children/Youth Attendance Records"

#### On Password Page:

• Enter "commitment"

#### On the Sign-in Page:

- Enter your Name
- Select the School or Parish for which you would like to enter information
- Select the program for which you would like to enter information:
  - Talking About Touching 2014
  - Called to Protect for Youth 2014
- Click "Continue"

#### On the Reporting Page, enter the numbers as requested:

- # of Children eligible for training
  - The number of children *required* in your school to attend training.
    - For *Talking About Touching*, that would be all students in Pre K Grade 3.
    - For Called to Protect for Youth, that would be all students in Grade 7.
- # of Children who participated in training
  - The total number of all children who participated in safe environment training.
    - If a student was absent for part of the program but attended part, they are counted as having attended.
- # of Children who did not participate due to opt-out
  - The number of opt-out forms you have on file at the school for students who opted-out of the entire program.
- Date Training Completed
  - Both programs require multiple days to complete the curriculum. Please enter the date the entire curriculum was finished in the school.
- Contact information
- At the bottom there will be a total account of student participants. If these numbers do not equal one another, not every student is accounted for. Please explain in the box for each student why they are not included in the tally. For example:
  - 1) Enrolled in school after curriculum was completed
  - 2) Was absent for all three sessions of Called to Protect for Youth
