VERIFICATION PROCESS

Each archdiocesan Level I school must submit the "VERIFICATION OF SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE" form by **June 15th!**

This form verifies the school has met all Safe Environment requirements for the 2013-2014 year, listed below.

All employees and any volunteer with ongoing unsupervised access to minors or vulnerable adults have:

- A cleared **Criminal Background Check** within the last three years
- Signed-off on **Safe Environment Abuse Prevention Policies**
- Completed required annual **Safe Environment Training**

In addition:

- All required students have completed Safe Environment training or a signed Opt-Out is on-file.
- All schools must have offered "Called to Protect for Parents & Families" to their community.
 - ~ *Please remember the class does not need to be hosted on-site but the school may advertise the class if it is being held at another location nearby.*

All forms and instructions are available in SETA Net in Forms/Articles in "2014 Verification Packets" and "Principal Resources."

PLEASE NOTE:

- *Verification forms must be signed by the Principal.
~ (The form may not be signed by the SEP Coordinator or Business Manager.)*
- *The **signed original form** must be received by the Safe Environment office on or before June 15th.*
- *Incomplete forms will not be accepted.*

SCHOOL VERIFICATION AND ATTENDANCE NUMBERS

In addition to the written Verification Form submitted by the Principal, each school must also submit student attendance numbers for all students who participated in *Talking About Touching* and *Called to Protect for Youth*. Please see page 64 of the Safe Environment Program Coordinator's Handbook or find instructions in SETA Net under "Forms/Articles." It was also included in the Verification Packet emailed to coordinators in May.

Schools will not be considered compliant until both the form AND attendance numbers have been submitted.

All Verification is due by June 15, 2014!
