The Fall 2014 In-Year course encompasses the introductory and continuum levels of the Slingerland Comprehensive Teacher Training Program. Clock hours available!

The Introductory level is the core of the Slingerland training program. Participants will learn to use the Slingerland format that supports the No Child Left Behind and National Reading Panel's key elements to upgrade their teaching skills for better student performance in reading, writing and spelling.

The continuum course includes a brief review of the introductory course then an introduction and practice of more advanced techniques in the language continuum. The use of the dictation paragraph and screening procedures will also be presented.

The course will consist of weekly lectures—four hours each. Course instructors will work with each participant to schedule individual demonstrations and observations at the participant's school or organization.

Participants must attend all sessions to satisfactorily complete the course.

*Prerequisites: *All Levels:* Acceptance to the course requires satisfactory completion or verification of acriminal background check.

Introductory Level

Course Content:

- ■Introduction in introductory steps of handwriting, written language, decoding and reading comprehension
- ■Understanding the etiology of dyslexia.
- ■Introduction of phonics rules and their application in encoding and decoding.
- ■Introduction to the neurology of language.
- ■Understanding of the development of oral language skills.
- ■Study of the history, philosophy and current research about dyslexia.
- ■Lesson plan preparation using current curriculum in the Slingerland® Approach.





Second Level Continuum
