Additional Information for School Teachers

Professional Development Credit

- 5 CCP classes (20 hours) earn 2 professional development credits at Seattle University. These classes must be taken within a 12-month period.
- A payment of \$50 made to "Seattle University" must be submitted to OCFF with a completed SU application form, available through Roberta Tassani.
- Participants are **required** to sign the SU Attendance Sheet at each class and the Catechist Certification Program Attendance Sheet.
- The Course Evaluation Form must also be completed and returned with the SU application.
- You may not use the same hours for Washington State Clock hours.

WA State Clock Hours

- Each CCP class earns 4 WA State Clock hours.
- Participants are **required** to sign the Clock hour Attendance sheet at each class and the Catechist Certification Program Attendance Sheet.
- Keep the Participant Certificate for your records.
- The Course Evaluation Form must be completed and returned to OCFF.
- You may not use the same hours for Professional Development Credits.

Each full year of CCP completed may earn
2 Seattle U credits and 8 WA State Clock Hours.

This program is for **Catholic School principals and teachers, Parish Religious Education staff, and volunteers** who are seeking Archdiocesan Catechetical Certification; **adults** attending for their personal faith development; **WA State Clock Hours or Seattle University Professional Credit** will be offered.

Cost

\$25 per class (Spirituality of the Catechist class is only \$10). Please write checks to **CCAS**. If you are making up a missed session, and have already paid the fee, funds may be transferred.

Please note:

To receive certification, it is preferred that participants attend Year 1 classes before Year 2 or 3. Year 2 and 3 may be interchanged.

The two-hour *Spirituality of the Catechist* session (listed in Year 3) will fulfill the Spirituality Component Requirement of the Program. It is a two-hour, retreat-like experience with no worksheet required.
