PILGRIMAGES IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF SEATTLE

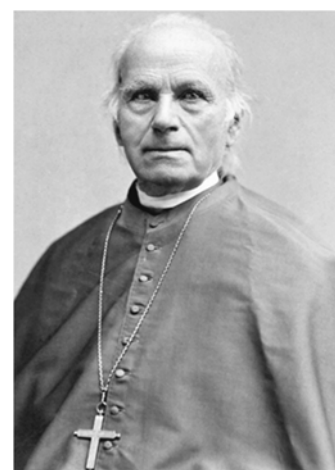


Proto-Cathedral of St. James, Vancouver • July 11, 2015

Explore the early roots of the Archdiocese and learn about the heroic efforts of Bishop A.M.A. Blanchet, Mother Joseph, and the Providence Sisters in establishing and spreading the faith. Begin the journey at the Proto-Cathedral of St. James, followed by a few stops, and arrive at Mother Joseph's grave, while reflecting and discussing the visible legacy these heroes have left all throughout Vancouver. The walking tour is 2.4 miles round trip with driving options available.

SCHEDULE

9:00—9:45 am	Morning Mass in the Proto-Cathedral
10:00—11:00	Exhibition Artifacts/ History of Founding of Catholicism in Northwest (Lower Hall)
11:00 am—12:00 pm	Tours of Proto-Cathedral (Tours will run continuously; pilgrims can attend tour first then see exhibits, or vice-versa.)
12:00—1:00 pm	Lunch on Piazza (or in Lower Hall, if inclement weather). Box lunches will be available for purchase (\$5 with advance reservation). Soda & water also available for purchase. Complementary coffee and tea.
1:00—1:30	Walk to Providence Academy (for short talk)
1:30—2:00	Walk to St. James Mission site (for short talk)
2:00—3:00	Walk/drive to Mother Joseph Cemetery (Explanatory map will be provided.)
