Learning Outcomes:

- Deepen personal understanding of the key dimensions of productive student discussion and its capacity to engage students of all abilities in extending their understanding of content.
- Become familiar with the "cycle of discussion," a tool for planning questions to prompt thinking, with structures to engage all, and scaffolds to deepen understanding.
- Assess three sets of skills (social, cognitive, and use-of-knowledge) requisite to student engagement in productive
- Explore three different forms of discussion teacher-guided, structured small-group, and student-driven and consider how each helps scaffold student skills and enables students to assume increased responsibility for learning through discussion.
- Apply the criteria for quality questions to craft discussions related to the unit plan template.
- Actively learn through participating in selected small-group structures, and reflect on the potential to engage all students more fully in learning standards-based content.
