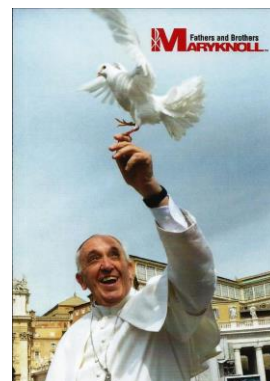

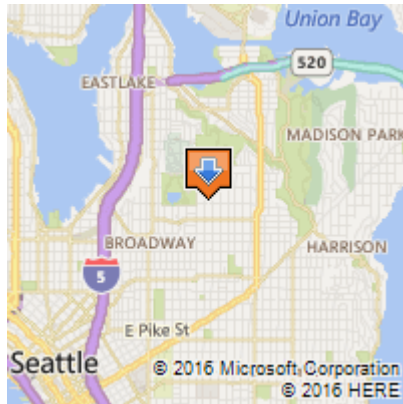
All Christians become missionary disciples at baptism and it's our job to form and accompany them as they go forth in joy to share the Good News.
