2017-18 Archdiocesan School Calendar

To assist Catholic school principals in their planning, the Office for Catholic Schools annually prepares the Archdiocesan Academic School Calendar. The calendar is attached to this email.

Per the Archdiocesan policy, the calendar has 180 days of student instruction. If a school calendar projects less than 180 instructional days, grades 9-12 shall have at least 1,080 instructional hours and grades K-8 shall have at least 1,000 instructional hours. In addition, the school's calendar should provide opportunities for teachers' professional growth and faith formation. Any variation from 180 days or 1080 / 1000 hours must be approved by the superintendent.

In consultation with the OCS staff and the Executive Principal Committee, the Office for Catholic Schools recommends the following dates for 2017-18 Catholic school calendar:

I would like to draw your attention to the February 16 - Faculty Retreat Day.
