Counselor Nomination Form**

Saint Martin's University will be giving out one Abbot Oswald Baran and three Abbot Neal Roth full-tuition scholarships beginning with the fall 2016 class. Scholarship recipients will be high-need students who attend a Catholic high school in Washington State and who exemplify at least one of the four core tenants of Saint Martin's University. Counselors, please nominate any seniors from your school who you feel would qualify for this award. **Submissions are due by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.**

- Students must be Pell Grant eligible, or demonstrate high need if unable to qualify for the Pell Grant due to immigration status; students will be required to submit a FAFSA or WASFA
- Recipients must meet minimum requirements for admission to Saint Martin's University
- Scholarship recipients are expected to live on campus
- Recipients will complete 5 servant leader hours a week as a cohort
- Students do not need to have already applied to Saint Martin's University to be nominated

**Four Core Tenants:**

**Faith:** Faith is the commitment we have to the exploration of our beliefs. We acknowledge the fundamental necessity of the human confrontation with faith in all its aspects—religious, interpersonal, political, social, in all the commitments required in a life—as a critical element in the pursuit of truth.

**Reason:** Reason means going beyond the mere productions of useful-skilled and employable graduates. It aims at producing thoughtful, educated, independent thinkers capable of, and interested in, making a positive difference in the world they inhabit.

**Service:** Service expresses essential elements of the Benedictine philosophy of hospitality. Saint Martin's nurtures the impulse to serve and aims to graduate men and women distinguished by their thoughtful commitment to help meet the needs of others.

**Community:** Community is a distinctive hallmark of the Benedictine philosophy that is the self-conscious regard for people's mutual inter-dependence and the way we embrace respect for all the roles in the human community.
