## **Committee Objectives:**

- Identify high-quality learning standards for Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten teachers that are vertically aligned to Kindergarten learning standards.
- Analyze a variety of Early Learning curricula using a rubric of committee- created essential criteria. Use the results of the curriculum analysis to make Archdiocesan recommendations.
- Develop observational assessment tools that can be used in Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, and Kindergarten classrooms.
- Develop a Kindergarten entry assessment tool and Kindergarten jumpstart toolkit that will help schools facilitate seamless and data-informed transitions from Pre-Kindergarten to Kindergarten.
