presented by Dr. Megan McClelland & Dr. Shauna Tominey of Oregon State University co-authors of Stop, Think, Act: Integrating Self-Regulation in the Early Childhood Classroom



**Dr. Megan McClelland** serves as Director of the Early Childhood Research Core at the Hallie Ford Center for Healthy Children and Families at OSU. Her research focuses on optimizing children's development, especially as it relates to children's self-regulation and school readiness including links between self-regulation and academic achievement from early childhood to adulthood, recent advances in measuring self-regulation, and intervention efforts to improve these skills in young children. She is currently involved with a number of national and international projects to develop measures of self-regulation, and interventions to improve school readiness in young children.



**Dr. Shauna Tominey** is an Assistant Professor of Practice and Parenting Education Specialist at OSU. Dr. Tominey served as the Director of Early Childhood Programming and Teacher Education at the Yale Center for Emotional Intelligence. As a former early childhood educator and family service professional, Dr. Tominey blends practical experience with research to develop and test programs aimed at promoting self-regulation and social and emotional skills for children and the adults in their lives Dr. Tominey holds undergraduate degrees in Music and Psychology from the University of Washington, an M.S. in Family Studies and Human Services from Kansas State University, and a Ph.D. in Human Development and Family Sciences from Oregon State University.

## Reimbursement Through Department of Early Learning (DEL)

The Department of Early Learning offers reimbursement for state-approved training costs for professionals currently employed in DEL licensed or certified facilities on a first-come, first-serve basis. You can apply one time each fiscal year (July 1 – June 30). Training must have been completed no more than 12 months prior to submitting your application. You may apply for up to \$250 and reimbursements are available on a first-come, first-serve basis since funds are limited for each fiscal year. **How do I apply?** Log into your MERIT account. Click on the Applications tab. Select Training Reimbursement. Follow the steps to complete and submit the application.
